SUMMARY

During the Biennium, there are times that budget adjustments are required to recognize changes in revenues and expenditures. The proposed budget amendments do not increase appropriations by more than ten percent and a public hearing is not required.

BACKGROUND AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Oregon budget law (ORS 294.471) provides for a mid-year amendment to the budget through the supplemental budget process. This supplement budget contains two types of amendments: the first is merely a transfer of appropriations from one category to another which does not increase nor decrease the original budget; and the second is an additional appropriation of revenue which will increase the total budget. Because these proposed changes consist of transfer and additional appropriation of less than ten percent of the budgeted fund, Oregon budget law allows adoption by Council Resolution with no public hearing required.

The budget amendment reflects multiple increases in appropriations. These include covering professional services charges related to processing debt service payments. The purchase of hardware and software in the Recorder's Office and Information Technology Department are being offset by savings from vacant positions in other areas.
