

Objective – Improve Cost Recovery

- Biennium 2019/21 Budget "General Fund Balancing Proposal"
 - Expenditure reductions and revenue enhancements
 - Proposal to increase building fees
 - Citizen Budget Committee endorsement
- Improve Cost Recovery for the Building Division
 - Growing Gap Permit revenues not keeping up with the cost of providing building program services
 - 2003 Last building permit fee increase
- Building Division 4 FTE (Building Official, Inspectors (2) & Permit Technician)
 - Comprehensive plan review, inspections and building code compliance
 - Oregon Building Code Continuing education and certification maintenance



- \$870,000ConstructionValuation

Commercial

- 30,000 Sq. Ft.
- \$3,700,000 Construction Valuation







SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCE - Total Permit Cost


MULTI_FAMILY HOUSING (Proposed) Building Permit Fees Only


MULTI-FAMILY HOUSING - Total Permit Cost

10 UNITS. 8,000 SQ.FT. \$870,000 VALUATION.




COMMERCIAL BUILDING (Proposed)

Revised Permit Fees and Projected Revenues

- Followed a similar fee schedule and format as other cities within the region
- Applied updated fee schedule to key permit types – comparison in the region
- Construction valuation of \$25 million used as a baseline year for projecting changes in permit revenue
- \$25 million in construction valuation is projected for both FY20 & FY21
- Set a 60% cost recovery target for the building division




Building Permit Fees - Proposal Summary



Single Family Residence

- Building Permit Fee increases from \$2,259 to \$3,394 or by 50%
- Total Permit Cost (including SDCs and Additional Fees) increases by \$1367, or approximately 5.8%.

Current Total Permit Cost \$23,535
Proposed Total Permit Cost \$24,892




Building Permit Fees - Proposal Summary



- Building Permit Fee increases from \$8388 to \$12,385 or by 47.5%
- Total Permit Cost (including SDCs and Additional Fees) increases by \$4,939 or approximately 5%

Current Total Permit Cost \$99,536
Proposed Total Permit Cost \$104,475



Building Permit Fees - Proposal Summary



Commercial Building

- Building Permit Fee increases from \$22,038 to \$35,371 or approximately 60%
- Total Permit Cost (including SDCs and Additional Fees) increases by \$15,843 or approximately 6.4%

Current Total Permit Cost **\$247,442**Proposed Total Permit Cost **\$263,285**






Permit Revenues – Projected Increase

- \$25,000,000 annual construction valuation
- Estimate an increase in annual permit revenue of approximately \$170,000
- Permits revenues would account for 60% of the cost of providing building division services
