Oregon budget law (ORS 294.471) provides for a mid-year amendments to the budget through the supplemental budget process.

This supplement budget will recognize and appropriate unbudgeted revenue. The Parks and Recreation Department has been awarded several grants as detailed in the Staff Supplemental Budget Request. These changes consist of additional appropriations of less than ten percent of the budgeted fund, Oregon budget law allows adoption by Council Resolution with no public hearing required.
