

Ambuja Rosen's Speech In Public Forum, 5/20/08

At the last Earth Day celebration, I ran into Councilor Kate Jackson, and we dialogued a bit about the tethering issue. I like Kate. Kate, if I say anything in this speech that's not accurate about you, please interrupt me and correct me. I've only spent a little time around Kate, but sometimes when I have, I've felt a natural affection for her.

One beautiful thing about Kate Jackson is that she recognizes that tying animals, or at least dogs, for a long time unattended at home is inhumane. I bet Kate has never treated one of her own animals that way.

Kate Jackson's objections to a tethering limit have been logistical, not philosophical. She told me she thinks the police have higher priorities than to enforce a tethering limit. I told Kate that I agree that on any given day, the police may have what they consider to be higher priorities, but that very few of these animals will be emergencies, with embedded collars, for example, or strangling to death on their tethers. If an animal's been chained for three years, what's one more week going to matter? The police can tend to what they consider higher-priority calls first, then come back, say, a week later for the animal.

Animal Control Officer Larry Herring told me that each complaint takes him only about an hour to enforce--and that's if it goes to court, which most of them don't. Based on the number of complaints in other jurisdictions, Ashland will get an initial flurry of maybe 20 complaints, then only about 3 or 4 complaints a month after that. And these complaints may diminish to zero over time.

Kate Jackson also told me that she didn't know whether this is a big enough problem in Ashland to legislate. This is a valid concern, and one the mayor had, too.

I told Kate the same things I told the mayor. I sent her a list of excessively chained animals that people have reported to me over the past two years. I told her these are probably only a small percentage of the animals in Ashland who are chained a lot. As two animal control officers stated in my last report, most chained animals are not visible from the street. Also, some people don't want to tell me about their neighbors' chained animals.

I also asked Kate Jackson, like I asked the mayor, to think creatively in terms of time and space. I don't know how many animals we have who are excessively chained, but let's say it's 50 to 100. We may have another 50 to 100 next year, and another 50 to 100 the next year, and so on. I told Kate that if she votes for this ordinance, she might help thousands of Ashland animals over the next few decades.

I also asked Kate Jackson to think creatively in terms of space, or geography. At our January 2007 hearing, the Southern Oregon Kennel Club apparently organized purebred dog breeders to come from as far as Eugene to oppose this. They know that this could spread to other places.

Colleen Macuk, Jackson County shelter director, told me that if Ashland's law works, she'll use that as documentation to try for a county law.

So I asked Kate Jackson to consider that if she votes for this, she may be helping thousands upon thousands of animals throughout our county and even beyond.

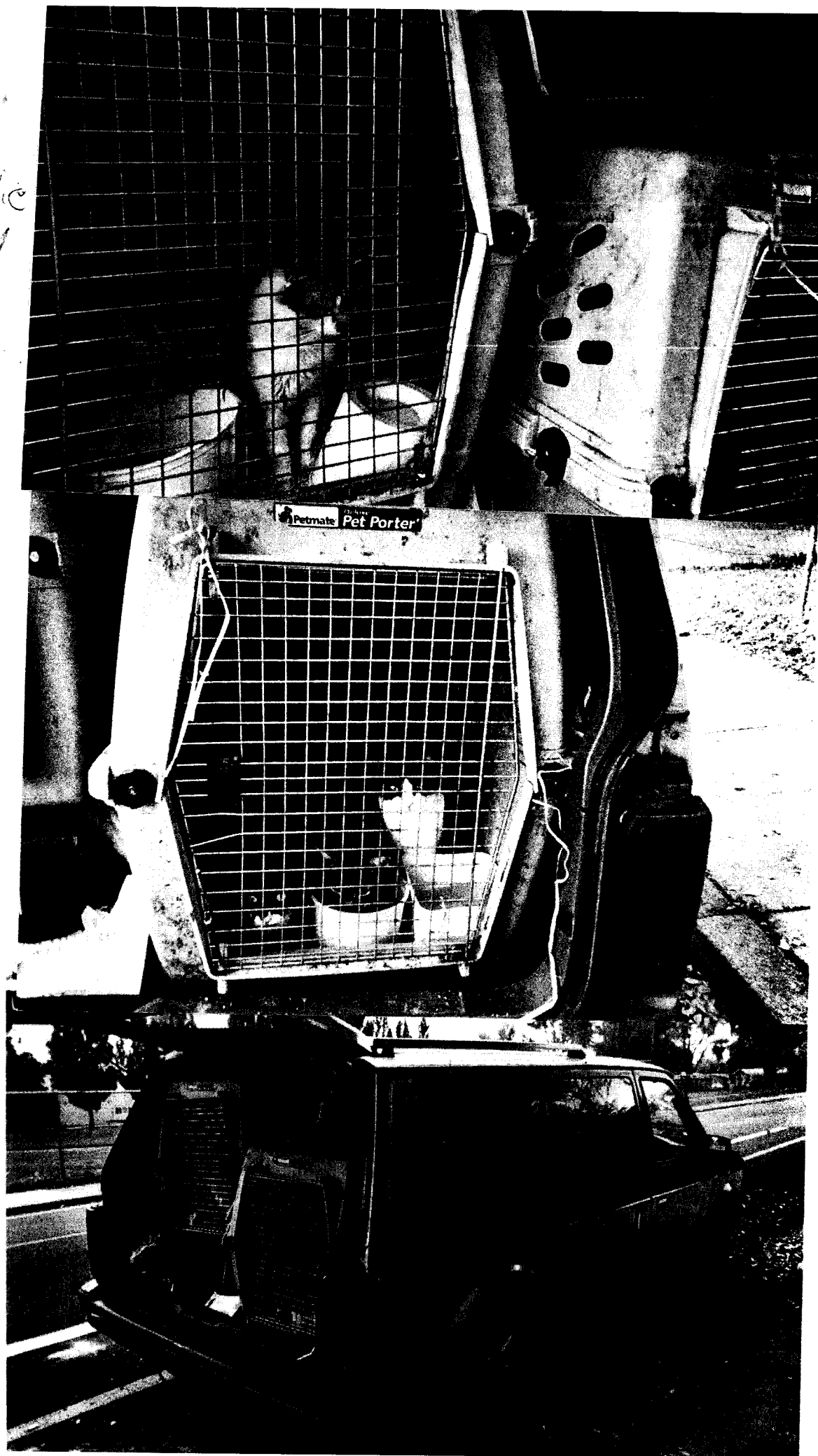
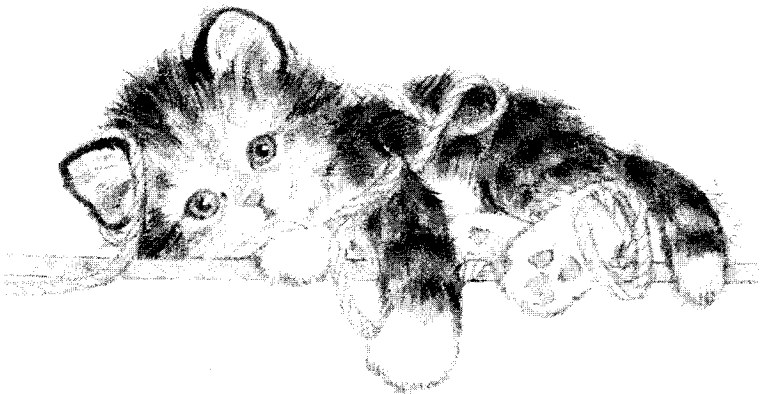
