Daily Highlights:

- **Small area of Talent reopened:** small area of Talent downgraded to a Level 2 thus reopening i.e. Anjou Club apartments and townhouses directly north as well as neighborhood to the west.
- Exit 21 Talent reopened to traffic late in the afternoon.
- **Deputy Medford City Manager, Kelly Madding** joined EOC to assist in establishing a Recovery Center.
- **FEMA** liaison arrived today for a preliminary meeting. She will be our representative starting tomorrow to provide guidance and assistance to rebuild our communities.
- FEMA Assistance Online Getting Started: The Governor's major disaster declaration has been approved, including eligibility for Individual Assistance, for Douglas and Jackson Counties. Information on how individuals can register for assistance will be at: <u>https://www.disasterassistance.gov/</u>
- Important Messages today:
 - FEMA will be on board tomorrow
 - We're working hard to get areas open. We anticipate more areas will be downgraded and reopened tomorrow in the Phoenix and Talent area.

 - Services at the EXPO continue to expand with La Clinica mobile medical clinic will be on-site Wednesdays and Fridays.
