Residential Resource Efficient
Clothes Washer Rebate Procedures

The City of Ashland Conservation Division is currently offering a resource efficient clothes washer rebate program in which the City will pay its residential utility customers for the installation of resource efficient clothes washers. Clothes washers with the ENERGY STAR™ label qualify for an \$80 City rebate if the home has an electric water heater and a \$40 rebate if the home has a gas water heater. More efficient models found on Oregon Department of Energy's (ODOE) list qualify for a \$100 City rebate if the home has an electric water heater and a \$50 rebate if it has a gas water heater. Models from the ODOE list will also qualify for a state tax credit. The following is the link to the ODOE list of models qualifying for these incentives:

In order to take part in the program you must:

- * Be a City of Ashland utility customer.
- * Be willing to have a water audit and/or physical inspection of the washing machine.

Once you have installed your new washing machine you need to call the Conservation Division at 552-2062 to schedule an inspection and/or audit. You may then either mail in the application (see reverse side) with a copy of the invoice for the washer or have it ready for the inspector upon arrival for the audit/inspection.
