## **Background and Additional Information:**

Staff has been meeting with representatives from the Amigo Club, SOU, the Ashland Chamber of Commerce, and the Ashland City Band to begin planning for the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations of our Sister City relationship with Guanajuato, Mexico. The basis for the plans is the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebrations which occurred in 2009. It is expected that a larger than normal contingent of Ashland representatives will travel to Guanajuato (likely during their Presa de la Olla festival in June) and an equally larger than normal contingent of Guanjuatenses will travel to Ashland (likely for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July celebrations) in 2019. If Council has any specific events or interactions they would like to propose as part of the planning process, this is the opportunity to give staff direction.
