Following graduation from college I taught high school marching band prior to enlisting in the US Navy and performing with the Navy Band Northwest for two years. I attended Officer Candidate School and was commissioned as an officer and served 30 years in the Navy, retiring as a Captain. At my final duty station I was the Dean of Students at the Naval Postgraduate School in Monterey California. I founded, performed with and later conducted a 35 member brass band composed of military students and faculty. Founded in 2003 it is still going strong today after 15 years. During my 30 year career I moved 14 times and volunteered for community bands at most of my assignments.

I do feel it would be advantageous to have further training in this field such as attending conferences or seminars. It is always important to keep learning and keep an open mind to changes in technology, public relations, organizational growth and wellness.
