YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR UNEMPLOYMENT CASH BENEFITS!

If your employer laid you off or reduced your hours, apply for regular unemployment benefits –we call it filing a claim. If there were reasons you couldn't file your claim when you were laid off, you may be able to receive cash benefits for the time you could not work.

If you were self-employed or a contract worker, apply for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA)—we call it filing a PUA claim. You might be able to get cash benefits for the time you could not work.
