- 1. Performed clearance and height pruning on upper OTW trails to waterfall area.
- 2. Performed clearance and height pruning on Snark and part of Jabberwocky.
- 3. Installed new Snark signs at trailheads (2).
- 4. Installed new posts and signs on Snark where snark meets USFS property.
- 5. Performed clearance and height pruning on Waterline Trail.
- 6. Performed data collection on White Rabbit trail for difficulty rating category (using IMBA rating system).
- 7. Cleared down tree on White Rabbit trail; performed clearance and height pruning on middle section of WR Trail.
- 8. Finished construction of rail fence on lower Red Queen Trail.
- 9. Widened Creekside trail in OTW and performed cribbing installation along bad section of OTW Creekside trail during summer in-water work period.
- 10. Performed locates along Water Treatment Plant road for upcoming closure sign installations.
- 11. Sprayed and removed Bald Face Hornets nest on middle of Bandersnatch Trail; sprayed wasps nest along TID Trail near Hald-Strawberry Property; sprayed wasp nest along upper Lithia Park trail.
- 12. Performed clearance and height pruning for safety/improve visual clearance at bottom of Rich's Trail above Lithia where bikes enter road.
- 13. Removed hanger/widowmaker over Snark Trail.
- 14. Removed some trail user "dog ordinance" signs along Park St. and Pinecrest after citizen complaint.
- 15. Installing new "dog ordinance" signs farther west down Pinecrest after request from another citizen.

- 16. Added 4,080 feet of trail (multi-use) for the Parks Commission's newly acquired Harshman Property (Acid Castles-Hitt Rd. property) to the city GIS trails layer, maps, and updated the master trails spreadsheet.
- 17. Finishing reconstruction of the North Mountain Park Bridge trail connection by next week, after performing in water culvert replacement and in-channel restoration work.
