Calle Guanajuato Fees and Map Discussion

The following restaurants have applied for Commercial Use Permits on the Calle Guanajuato for the 2017 season:

- Sesame
- Louie's
- Salame
- Greenleaf
- Mix Sweet Shop
- Lithia Artisans Market
- Little Tokyo

According to the current Calle Guanjuato Commercial Use Policy, the Ashland Parks and Recreation Commission has the ability to review and set the square footage fee on the Calle prior to February 28<sup>th</sup> of each year. At the study session on Monday, February 13, staff will present information on the direct and indirect costs related to the Calle Guanajuato and review a draft boundary map that includes the requested locations by the restaurants and the Lithia Artisans Market for the 2017 season.

The current fees for the Calle are \$7 per square foot for restaurants and \$5 per square foot for the Lithia Artisans Market.
