At its January 5, 2021 Business Meeting, Council clarified that it was interested in utilizing the list of interested candidates that were part of a previous vacancy application process as well as to advertise for additional applicants. Announcement and advertising of the position vacancies were initiated and completed by City Recorder Melissa Huhtala with an application deadline of February 1, 2021.

As of January 28, 2021, there are a total of nine applicants for the now three vacant positions. Council is scheduled to fill the vacancies at the March 2, 2021 regular business meeting. The final applications and appointment process will be a part of the Council meeting packet.
