**Title:** Public Hearing and Adoption for Resolution Certifying City Provides Sufficient Municipal Services to Qualify for State Subventions and a Resolution Declaring the City's Election to Receive State Revenues

## **Summary:**

In order for the City to receive State Shared Revenue, the City must certify services and elect to receive State funds during a public hearing. The two resolutions proposed for approval after the completion of the public hearing:

## **Actions, Options, or Potential Motions:**

I move to approve a resolution titled "Resolution Certifying City Provides Sufficient Municipal Services to Qualify for State Subventions."

And

I move to approve a resolution titled, "A Resolution Declaring the City's Election to Receive State Revenues"

## **Staff Recommendation:**

Staff recommends approval of both resolutions associated and consistent with the recommendations made.

## **Policies, Plans and Goals Supported:**

2.1 Engage community in conversation about core services, desired service levels and funding mechanisms.

## **Background and Additional Information:**

Council certifies that the City qualifies for subventions (revenues shared by the state) by resolution each year. Additionally, Council annually adopts a resolution electing to receive an apportionment of the Oregon Department of Administrative Services General Fund revenues derived from taxes imposed as part of state revenue sharing. These are both necessary steps in order to continue receiving state shared revenue.
