construct a new residence on hillside lands with severe constraints. This is before the tree commission to review the tree removal/protection and planting plan.

COMPREHENSIVE PLAN DESIGNATION: Rural Residential; ZONING: RR-.5; MAP: 39 1E 09CC; TAX LOT: 1301

Staff briefly presented the application and mentioned that some of the trees shown were already removed during the installation of the driveaway. Staff requested that the tree commission consider the allowance of a flexible fencing rather than chain link due to the steep topography. Debrah Anderson at Terrace above the property was present to speak in favor of saving as many trees as possible based on the western exposure.

The tree commission reviewed the planting plan and felt that there were more trees being planted than being removed and that the species selected appeared to be appropriate for the aspect of the hillside and the hot sun that it will receive. The tree commission discussed the flexible fencing and was in favor. There was general agreement that the home site was set up in such a way
