YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR UNEMPLOYMENT CASH BENEFITS!

- ➔ **If your employer laid you off** or reduced your hours, apply for regular unemployment benefits—we call it filing a claim. If there were reasons you couldn't file your claim when you were laid off, you may be able to receive cash benefits for the time you could not work.
- ➔ **If you were self-employed or a contract worker**, apply for Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA)—we call it filing a PUA claim. You might be able to get cash benefits for the time you could not work.
