#### Respite from the Heat

When temperatures exceed safety thresholds, the City of Ashland usually opens a daytime cooling shelter. The City may open a full-time shelter under smoke conditions. Check for announcements at <u>ashland.or.us</u>.

Ashland Library, 410 Siskiyou Blvd, 541-774-6980, always welcomes visitors during their open hours: M-Th 10am-7pm, F 10am-6pm, Sa-Su, 12-5pm

Or find a shady respite in one of 19 parks in the City of Ashland, including:

- Garfield Park splash pad, open daily 10am-8pm
