Artist Spotlight: Susan Eileen Burnes

Our July through September 2023 art exhibit at Ashland Senior Center features fiber art by professional artist Susan Burnes.

Following a career as a psychiatric nurse in Cleveland, Ohio, Susan turned her focus to her love of fiber art in 1993. She has since had over 45 exhibits and received 7 art awards. She moved to Rogue River in 2001 and has served as the Chair of the Exhibition Department at the Grants Pass Museum of Art for 18 years.

About her work, Susan says, "I am inspired by the rhythms and patterns of my environment and nature. I work to express the underlying order of life, listening intently to the artwork as it develops and informs direction. I require the quiet, empty spaces to breathe, to dream and to create. My artwork is a realization of these natural processes. I intend to convey the experience of unity and harmony through the repetition of simple geometric forms in linear patterns."
