Patron Spotlight: Anne Bellegia

Congratulations to senior Anne Bellegia for receiving the prestigious Andrus Community Service Award from AARP Oregon last month.

Anne works tirelessly on behalf of seniors throughout the Rogue Valley. She is a thoughtful and respected advocate for policies and education to improve lives for seniors and family caregivers. Anne is a founding member of the Ashland Senior Advisory Committee, which advises the Ashland Parks and Recreation Commission and the City Council on the needs of local seniors. She also co-chairs the Livable Ashland Alliance, which is working on "all-age-friendly" livability improvements for Ashland.

In addition, Anne is an extraordinary, long-term volunteer with Osher Lifelong Learning Institute (OLLI) at SOU. In addition to organizing and teaching courses over the years, she is instrumental in marketing efforts, organizes an annual OLLI Open House



attended by over 800 seniors, and coordinates the OLLI community education series on critical topics related to aging. Anne formerly served on the regional Senior Advisory Council for Rogue Valley Council of Governments. She is currently helping form a local caregiver cooperative to support caregivers and attract more people to this critical service field.

Ashland Fire & Rescue Smoke Detector Program

Did you know that smoke detectors should be installed

Beep!

on every level of your home including the basement, inside each bedroom, and in the hallway outside each bedroom? Test the alarm on your smoke detector once a month by pushing the "test" button. If your detector is chirping, it is time to replace the battery or the detector.

Ashland Fire & Rescue is offering free smoke detectors with installation, or free smoke detector testing. Sign up at the Ashland Senior Center office or call 541-488-5342. Please allow up to 8 weeks for Ashland Fire & Rescue to contact you for an appointment.
