Patron Spotlight: Verl "Rowdy" Yates

Verl "Rowdy" Yates was born 1937 in Reno, Nevada. Throughout his life, he has lived all over Northern California and Southern Oregon. His family came to Ashland in 1947, and he graduated from Ashland High School in 1955. His senior year, he won first place in a singing competition at school.

Rowdy got his nickname from a boss who called him "a rowdy S.O.B.", and he also identified with Clint Eastwood's character, Rowdy Yates, in *Rawhide*. Rowdy worked for many years as a sawyer for McGrew Bros. Sawmill. He also served as a reserve officer for the Ashland Police, in many positions with the Ashland School District, country music DJ at KWIN and landscaper. After retiring at age 55, Rowdy built sets for local theaters. Rowdy has two sons, who live with their families in Oregon. He enjoys their visits with his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.



Rowdy comes to Ashland Senior Center for the Food & Friends lunch every weekday and participates in the weekly Discussion Group. He enjoys the friendly and warm conversations and peoples' positive attitudes at the Senior Center. He says "it picks him up" to come here.

Help with Medicare Drug Costs

Thanks to a new federal law, many people with Medicare will qualify for additional savings on Medicare



Part D drug coverage starting in 2024.

If you make less than \$22,000/year (\$30,000 for married couples), you may qualify for Medicare "Extra Help." You can cut your Medicare Part D premium to \$0 and greatly reduce your prescription drug co-payments. Go to Medicare.gov/ExtraHelp to see if you qualify.
