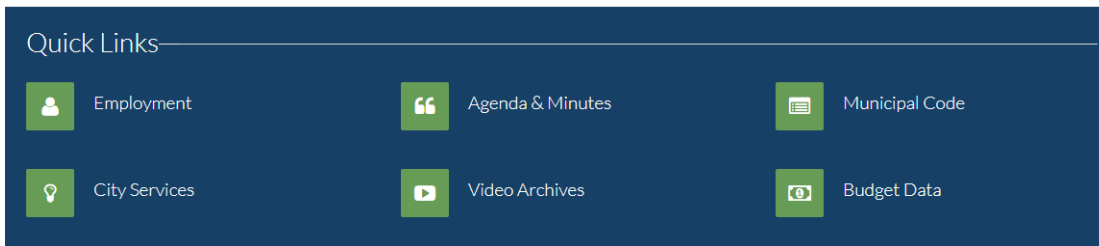

Agendas & Minutes: Council agenda packets, and minutes will be posted here. For agenda packets and minutes for advisory bodies, select the advisory body's webpage underneath the City Commissions tab at the top of any page within the City website.

Municipal Code: The Municipal Code and Land Use Ordinance is posted here. This is an interactive tool which allows you to search for key words or select by the table of contents.









City Services: This section provides a short cut to the following items: ADA information, AF&R Ambulance Membership, Ashland Fiber Network, Electric Services Rates, Equal Pay Program, Interim Billing Authorization, Making Sense of Your Utility Bill, Miscellaneous Fees and Charges, Parks and Recreation, Pay Your Utility Bill Online, Solid Waste & Recycling, Storm Drain Rates, Street User Fees, Utility Assistance Programs, Utility Connection Request Order, and Wastewater and Water Rates.

Video Archives: This page holds all of the meetings filmed by RVTV including City Council business meetings and study sessions, Parks and Recreation meetings, Budget Committee meetings, and occasional special meetings.

Budget Data: This links to the OpenGov platform which allows users to view budget reports and data as well as stories created to help give context to Ashland’s financial situation.

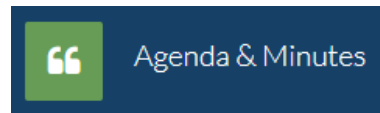
Fire Danger: All updates on the fire season and current fire danger will be presented here. You can also view the fire danger level in the footer of the webpage.

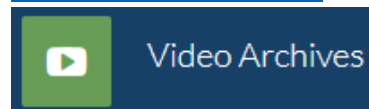

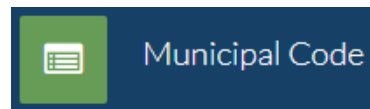
