⁸² surveys were collected after the Southbound concert performance, from an audience of 375.

Approximately 51% of surveys indicated an increase in interest/appreciation of the cultures represented in the performance. Remaining respondents sustained an existing high interest in cultures represented in the performance.

Approximately 96% of surveys indicated that individuals would a.) seek more of what the represented culture has to offer, and b.) look to Rogue World Music for more cultural opportunities in the future.

The \$5,000 grant enabled 7 world music events in Ashland that engaged nearly 1,300 people, nearly half of whom were children or seniors. This was made possible because of the 2017 City of Ashland grant. We thank you for financially supporting these experiences that build community and cultural awareness in Ashland.
