Ms. Brown went over the results of the comprehensive cost comparison for the water treatment plant (WTP).

She explained the costs to operate two separate WTPs are not in the best interest of the City.

- Landslide and fire needs.
- Timeline and location to build new.
- Storage needed.
- What to do with the old plant.
- Personnel increase/decrease with a new larger plant.
- TAP usage.
