

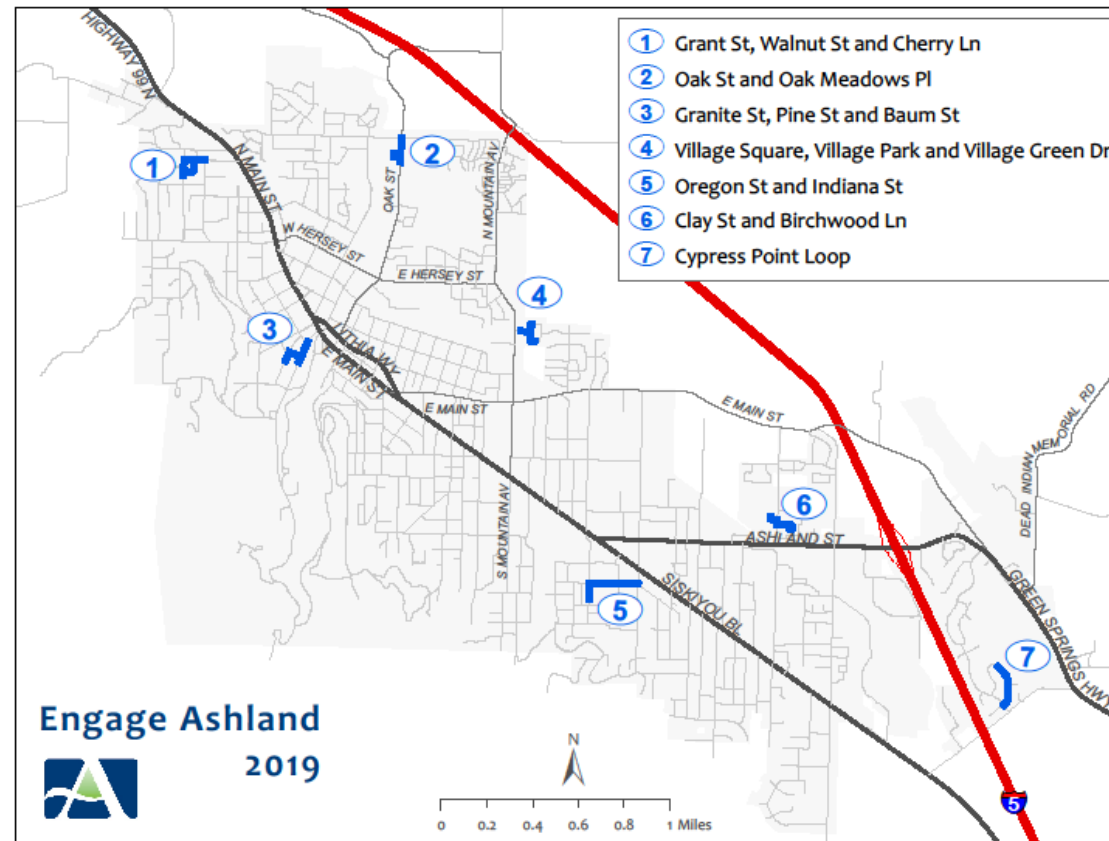

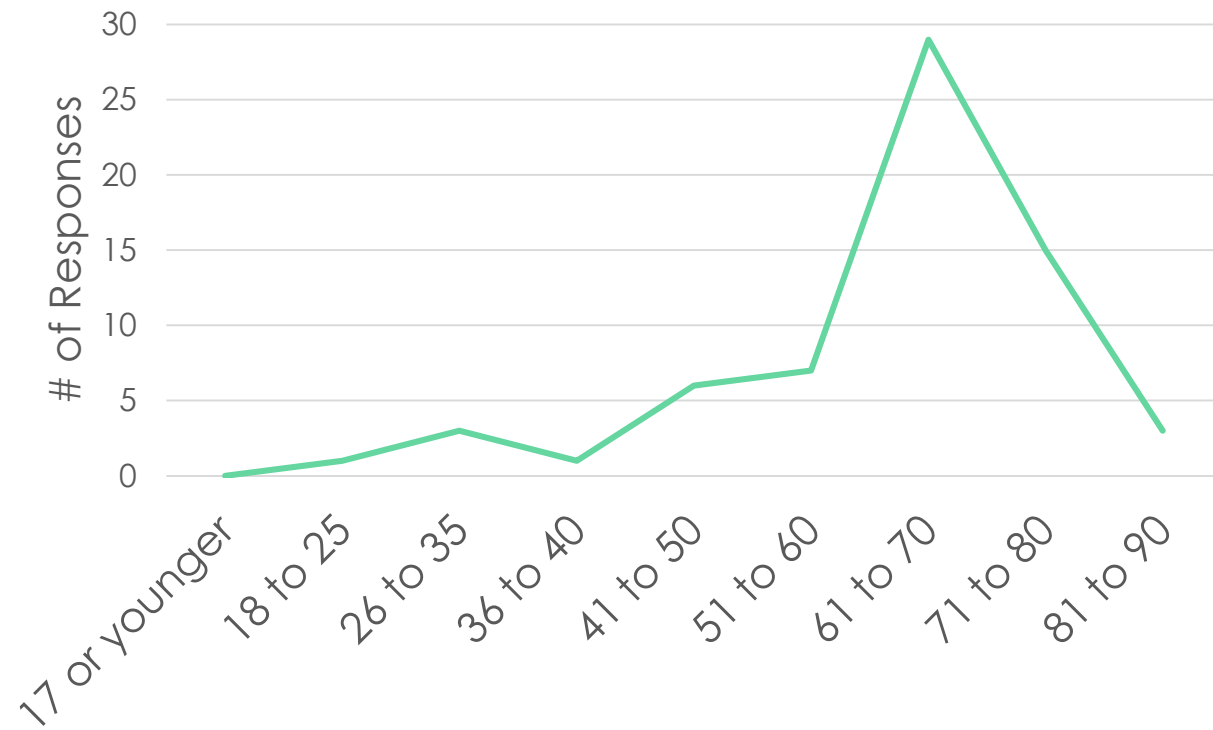
7 teams of Councilors and staff.

44 residents answered the door.

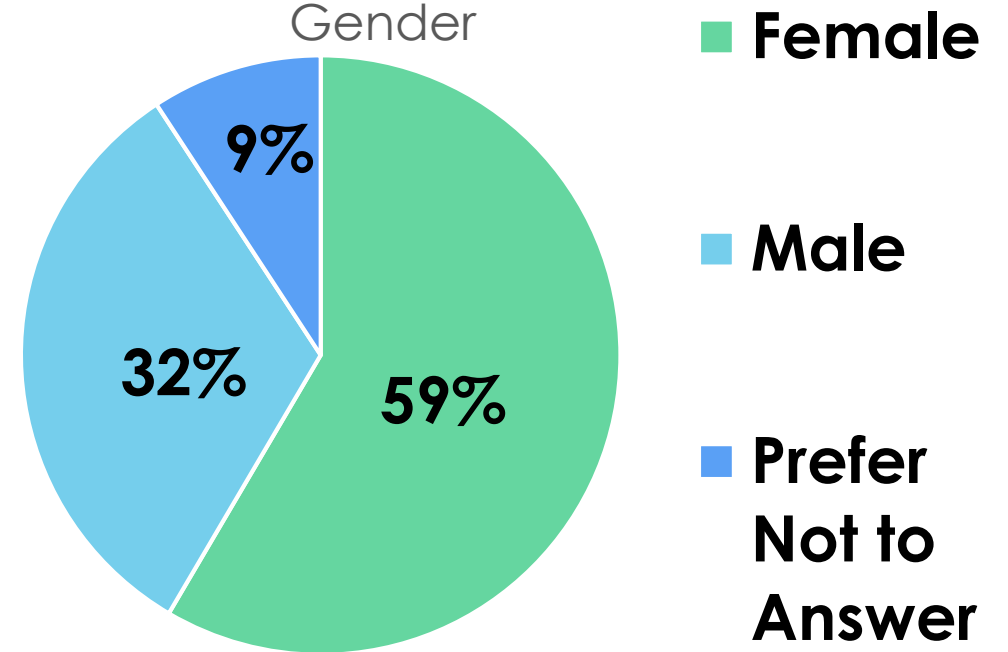
65 residents took the survey online or on paper.

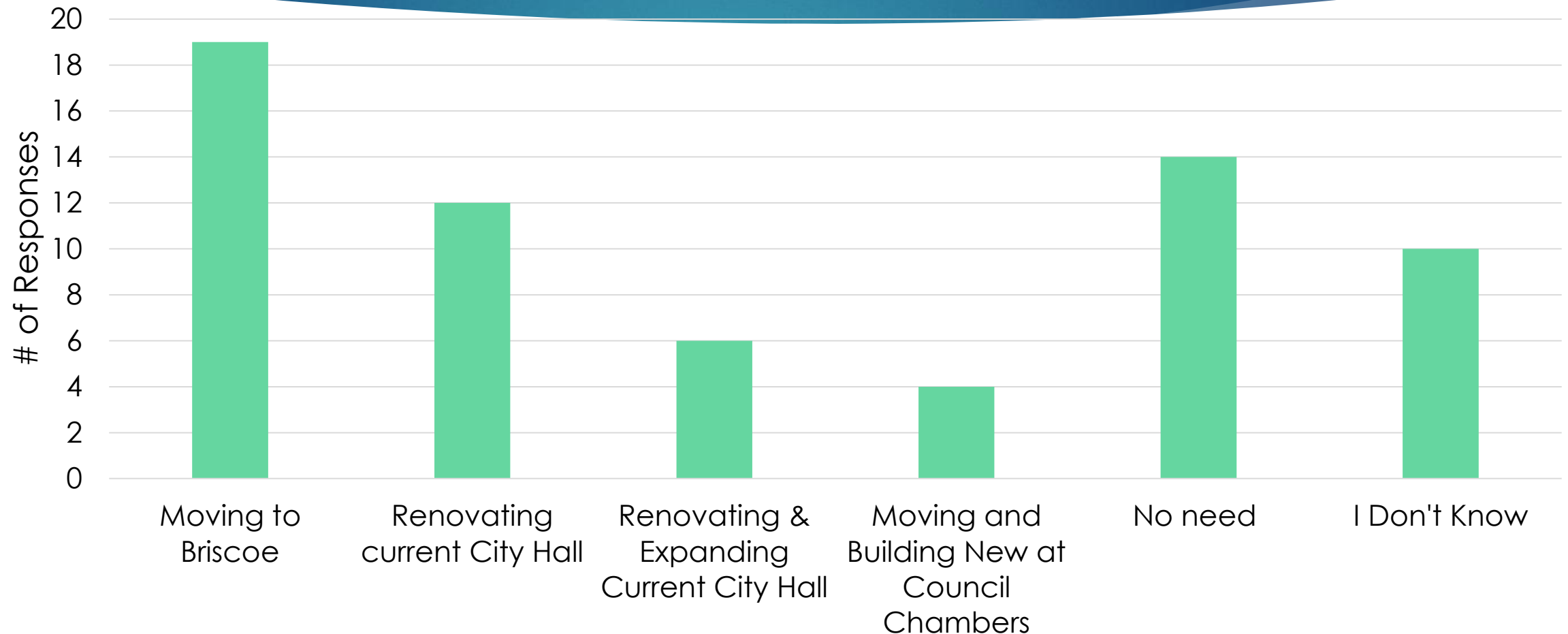

Utility Billing	54%

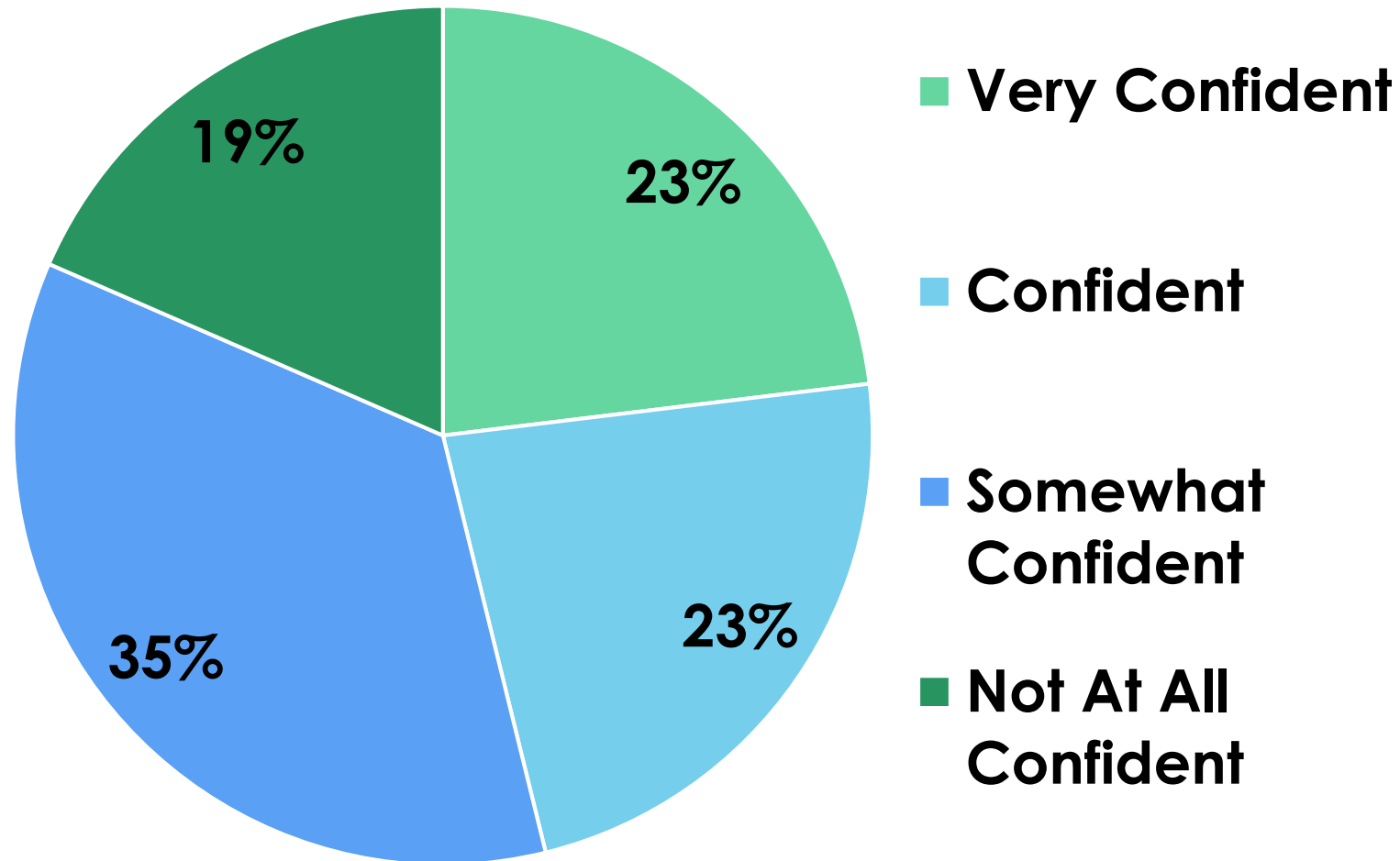
City Hall Proposed Sites

How do you feel about the proposed City Hall sites?



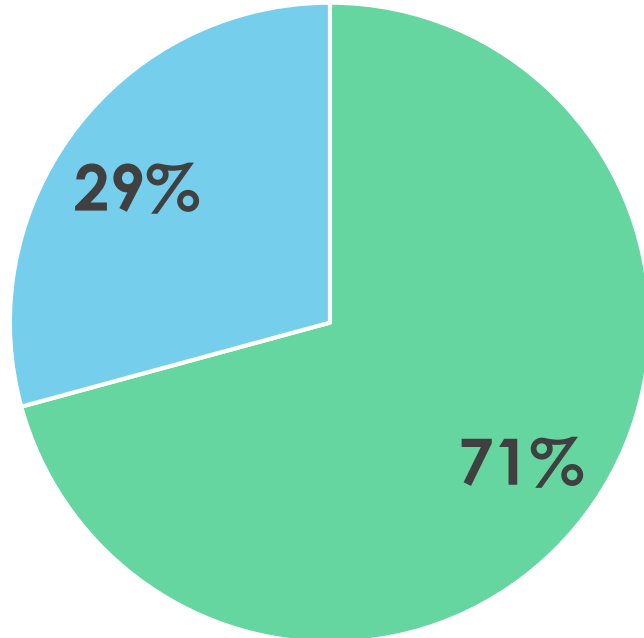
Emergency Situations

How confident are you that you would be prepared for an emergency situation (e.g. wildfire, flooding, etc.)?



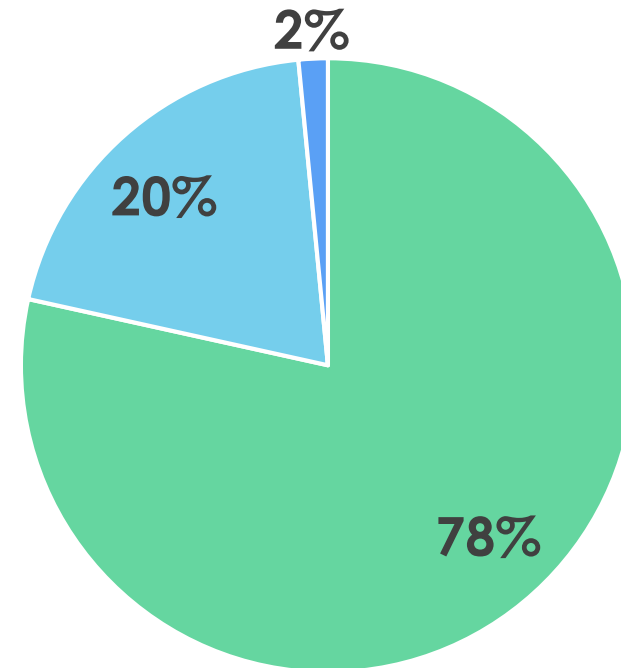
Climate and Energy Action
